Hang Seng Table Tennis Academy Celebrates Achievements of Rising Young Stars at 2022 Graduation Ceremony

Hang Seng Bank and the Hong Kong Table Tennis Association ('HKTTA') came together today at the Bank's Headquarters Building to celebrate the hard work and outstanding performances of young local table tennis talent at the Hang Seng Table Tennis Academy ('Academy') 2022 Graduation Ceremony.

The Academy organised 77 training courses providing 763 hours of elite training in 2022. The youngest player among this year's 94 graduates is only nine years old. The new graduates also include five junior players who have qualified to join the Hong Kong Youth Representative Team.

Presiding guests Diana Cesar, Executive Director and Chief Executive of Hang Seng; Tony Yue, Chairman of HKTTA; and Vincent Liu Ming-kwong, Director of Leisure and Cultural Services, presented 24 awards to graduating students and Academy scholarship awardees.

Diana Cesar said: "Today's ceremony is recognition of the hard work and perseverance of the Academy's young sporting graduates, who have demonstrated commitment, determination and drive over the past year in seeking to enhance their skills and perform at a high level. Hang Seng's brand values reflect similar characteristics and spirit. We are proud to be a part of helping these talented young people to achieve their potential. We also thank our long-term partner, HKTTA, for its tremendous contributions to the development of table tennis in our city. The Association has played a central role in putting Hong Kong on the international table tennis map."

Tony Yue said: "HKTTA and Hang Seng have been closely working together for 32 years to popularise and advance elite table tennis in Hong Kong. The Academy plays a crucial role in nurturing young players with good potential into elite athletes. Benefiting from the Academy's resources, facilities and coaches, many local table tennis players have gone on to hold their own and compete at a high level on the international stage. The Academy is committed to promoting table tennis throughout the local community to attract more talent and ensure the sport continues to grow."

Academy alumni Wong Chun-ting and Olympic team bronze medallist Minnie Soo Wai-yam shared career and play insights with two young 'Stars of Tomorrow' award winners, Hayson Chow Hoi-sun and Tang Ho-yan.

The ceremony also featured a friendly match between the Academy's Best Player of 2022, Li Honman, and Hong Kong team player Lam Siu-hang. Their lively rallies delighted the attendees, embodying the energetic spirit and energy of Hong Kong table tennis.

In addition, 5 out of 6 table tennis players who represented Hong Kong in the 2022 Olympics are Academy graduates. The Academy has held nearly 8,000 activities, benefiting over 420,000 people. The Academy cultivates talents in four areas: athlete training, coach training, technical training and sports education. It provides high-quality table tennis courses, teaching materials, technical support, etc. at different levels to allow table tennis enthusiasts with different technical levels to participate and become part of the Academy.
